E (1) Introduction :- Various threat surround the world, in which one is Pollution. Now-a-days, Pollution is increasing rapidly due to various human activities and which destroys the mankind and almost harmful for all the creature of the world. In India, there is considerably increase in pollution rate, in which metropolitan cities suffer most.

Meaning of Pollution and Cause :- "Pollution means the change in the chemical, physical and biological form of water, air, soil which is very harmful."



Cause :- Various cause of Pollution, like deforestation, chemical pollutants from industries and sewage, and various Non-biodegradable pollutants like Lead, Arsenic, and some secondary pollutants like PAN (Peroxy acetyl nitrate). These comes from the smoke of automobiles and from household purpose.

Types of Pollution :- There are mainly four types of pollution -

- (1) Air pollution - Unwanted change in properties of Air by various factor like smoke, PAN, increase in CO_2 and N_2O , SO_2 like gases. causes air pollution.
- (2) Water Pollution - Harmful and unwanted change in properties of water by sewage, pesticides, weedicides etc.
- (3) Soil Pollution - decrease in fertility of soil due to excess use of chemical fertiliser. ultimately harmful for the crops.

(4) Sound pollution (Noise) ~~pollution~~ - Unwanted change in intensity of sound which is unbearable or causes pain is called Noise.
