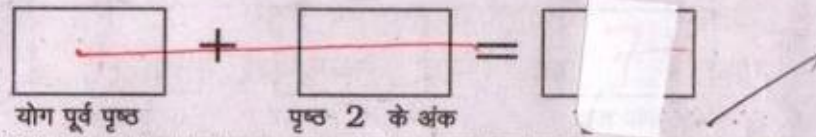

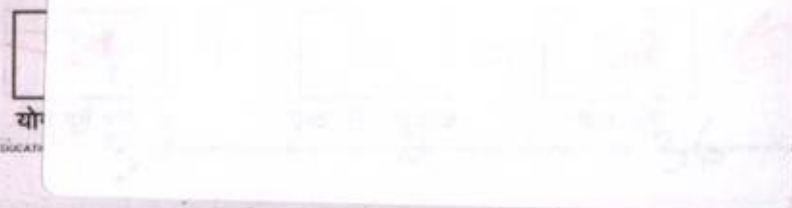

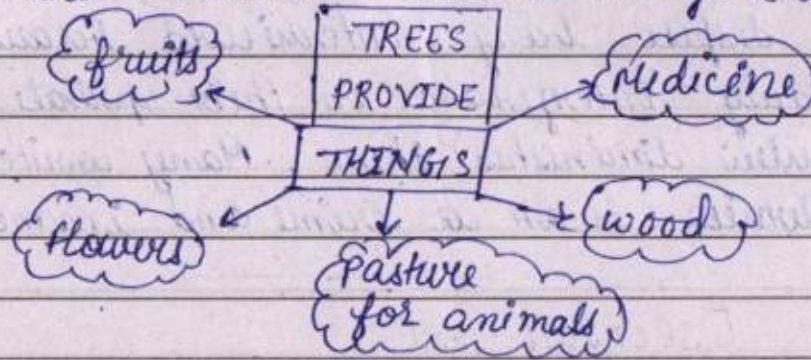
'Importance of Trees'

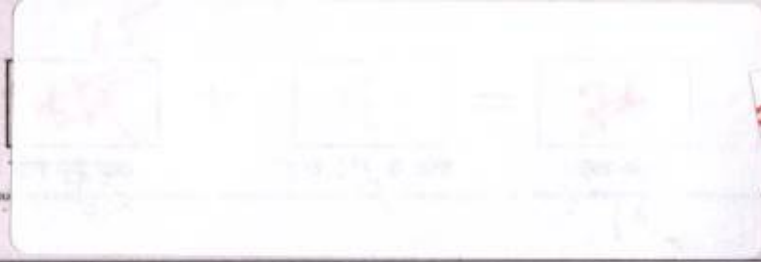
The whole summer I visited historical monuments as travelling gives more knowledge than books.
