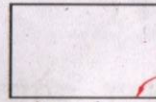

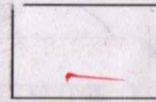
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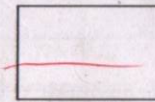

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SECTION-BQuestion-3(i) Science and Technology :-

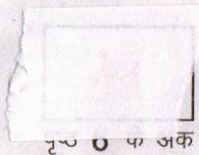

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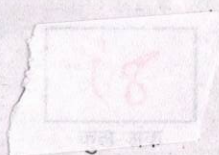

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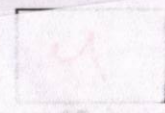
Question 10 (i)

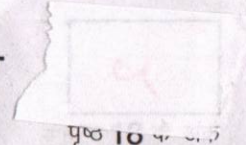
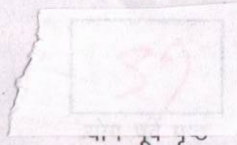
In the chapter 'Interview' the opinions of many celebrities about interviews has been mentioned.

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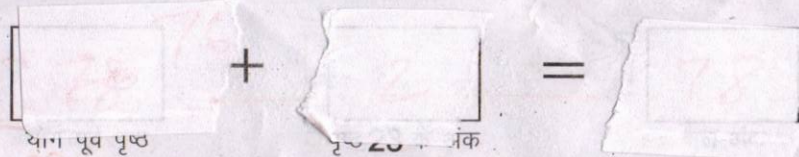


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Question-14 (iii)
